Questions:

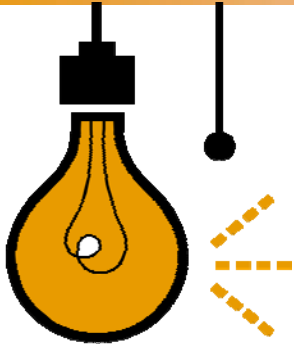

## Inside Story Headline Joshua 4

**1**And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the LORD spake unto Joshua, saying, **2**Take you twelve men out of the people, out of every tribe a man, **3**And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night. **4**Then Joshua called the twelve men, whom he had prepared of the children of Israel, out of every tribe a man: **5**And Joshua said unto them, Pass

over before the ark of the LORD your God into the midst of Jordan, and take ye up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes of the children of Israel: **6**That this may be a sign among you, *that* when your children ask *their fathers* in time to come, saying, What *mean* ye by these stones? **7**Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever.

**8**And the children of Israel did so as Joshua commanded, and took up twelve stones out of the

midst of Jordan, as the LORD spake unto Joshua, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, and carried them over with them unto the place where they lodged, and laid them down there. **9**And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day. **10**For the priests which bare the ark stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the LORD commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses commanded Joshua: and the people hastened and passed over
